- Q. What is the main purpose of Tecate Mission International? We exist to serve Jesus Christ and His Church by reaching the lost, developing mature disciples, and building God's Kingdom in Mexico and the uttermost parts of the earth.

Q. Is the purpose the same throughout each department of TMI?

Yes, the missionaries sign annually that that they are in agreement with the statement of purpose of TMI.

- Q. When did TMI begin? 1962
- Q. Where are the headquarters of TMI located?

1500 feet from the Mexican/American border in Tecate, CA

Q. How is TMI supported?

Individuals and churches send donations to assist in the cost of running the mission. TMI is a 501(c)3, non-profit organization. Donors will receive a tax deductible receipt within 10 days of their gift/donation being received at headquarters.

Q. Does TMI have any debt?

No, TMI operates in the black.

Distinctives of TMI

TMI is non-denominational-all must be united on basic doctrinal beliefs

TMI operates in the black-no debt

TMI is a faith mission with all missionaries and ministries responsible for their own partnership team. Each receives 100% of designated funds.

All major decisions made by the Executive Board must be unanimous.

Ministries Locations and Outreach

- Q. How many churches are under the covering of TMI? 20
- Q. What additional ministries are connected with the churches

Feeding programs, street and park evangelism, children's clubs, youth emphasis, marriage conferences, film showings, and more.

- Q. Do TMI churches in Mexico belong to a Mexican Religious Association? Yes. We desire to obey the regulations of the Mexican government by maintaining a religious association to which all of TMI churches are members.
- Q. What benefit is it for the churches to belong to TMI? *legal protection provided by TMI's A.R. Association
- * encouragement that results from shared membership
- *representation in TMI publications.
- Q. Are the ministries of TMI only located in the U.S. and Mexico?

No, we have a couple (TMI missionaries) working in Tanzania, Africa, and another couple in Spain. We also have Bible correspondence students in different Spanish-speaking countries such as Cuba.

Q. Tecate Christian School began in 1968. What feedback do you receive from TCS alumni?

Former students ask for prayer or counsel and some share how God has used the school to establish them in their life of faith as adults. Several of the graduates have their children enrolled.



Q. Explain the ministry, *The Nations Among Us*. Dan & Debbie Bender are ministering to refugees who are struggling to make a new life in America.

Q. What do you hope to accomplish through the Distribution Center

Ministries?

We desire to meet the physical needs of people and use the items to show God's love and care for them and thus take advantage of every opportunity to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

- Q. Does TMI still have a ministry to those incarcerated? Yes, there is teaching, and communication in different ways. Emphasis is also placed on helping those who re-enter life after prison.
- Q. Why do you continue with Bible lessons by correspondence sent through the mail? Can't students receive this same teaching on-line?

The majority of the students do not have access to computers, and many are in studying in prison facilities.

Q. How many of the 70 members and 9 retirees receive a salary from TMI?

No one. Every member must have a partnership/ support team (raise 100% of funds necessary for life and ministry).

Q. How can interested people participate in TMI?

They can invest their time (which includes work and prayer), talents, and treasures.
